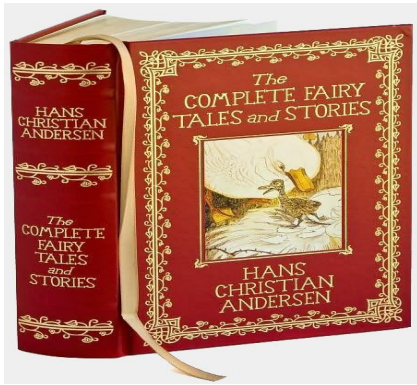

‘Tell me a story’

Each week the following will be set Wednesday and due following Tuesday

- ♦ **3 x 5 minute** phonics practice in homework books
- **3 x 10 minute** reading for pleasure
- **3 x 5 minute** verbal number practice

For reading, parents should listen to their child read their school reading book, ask questions about the story and record any observations in the reading diary. For phonics and maths, a sheet will be provided and stuck in home learning books, making the weekly task clear. We ask parents to sign the check box (stuck into home learning book with the weekly tasks) to say your child has completed the tasks. Thank you.

Across the term your child should complete. These should be in school on the specified date...

1. Make and Do Project due 30th October: Shoe Box Story

Create a shoe box scene from a favourite story. Shoe boxes should be decorated and filled with objects that give clues as to the story title. The more decorative and creative the better! Words can be used too eg well known phrases. The shoe boxes will then be used in school to create a whole class display + game ‘Guess The Story’

2. Verbal presentation due 22nd November: My Favourite Story

Between 2 and 3 minutes long; ideally presented in video format (submitted by email or on secure data storage) or, if not possible, delivered verbally in class. The presentation should encourage the child to speak like a TV presenter with enthusiasm. It should be about the story and why your child likes it. Make it fun
