Extra-curricular clubs

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There are a number of ways that all parents and carers can get involved. We will also need volunteer helpers for our fundraising events and activities throughout the year so if you are available on the day or to help with the organisation just send us a message via Classlist or a note left at the office to let us know.

New for this year we have also agreed to organise a FORPS school maintenance working group to help maintain the school building and grounds. This group will meet as required but there is already quite a long list of jobs that need doing so the first get together will be @2:30pm on Sunday 7th October. All the details are on Classlist, but if you have any questions you can talk to either myself, or Wayne Mott, any parent or teacher should be able to direct you to in the playground.

In terms of a fundraising target and what we are raising funds for this year, we are hoping to be able to raise over £6,000 again this year. We already have £8,750 raised from previous years and so we are exploring the logistics of using the existing concrete slab by the small playground to site a new structure to provide an additional breakout/classroom/practice space. This would require planning permission and it is not something that we can rush but it would be a fantastic achievement and boost for the school if we can make this happen. If anyone has any expertise, skills or resources that could benefit this project then please let either myself or Mr A. know.
