Week 2: 14.9.20	Yr 2 Numbers to 100 (Block 1 Theme 4 WRM pg 35-44) Year 2: ➤ Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and words ➤ Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens/ones)
