Staff Transition:

Rusper Primary School will be sad to say goodbye to Mrs. Pinder at the end of this term. Mrs Pinder has decided the time is right to move on, and we collectively thank her for all her great work. Under her management, RPS has made significant steps forward. We wish her well for the future.

School leaders and governors have already begun the process to find a new school business manager for January 2019. Parents and carers will be kept fully informed once we have successfully appointed a new person into the role.

Daily Mile Mornings

We would like to keep encouraging pupils, accompanied by their parents, to use our school grounds for morning exercise before school. If your child wishes to use the gym equipment, it is essential from a safety point of view, that a parent or carer should watch their child from a close distance whilst they are on any piece of equipment. Additionally, please do not leave your child on-site unsupervised before the doors open at 8.50am. Thank you.

Manga Maths

The Mangahigh online maths site is both popular and effective at raising standards in pupils core number skills. Log ins have now been issued to our Y1 and 2 pupils. Tasks will be set weekly by class teachers, which pupils should complete as part of homework. To have the most impact, pupils should access the Manga site little and often e.g. 15 mins per day. To incentivise this, one pupil from each year group, each week will receive a certificate for the most complete activities in Friday's celebration assembly.





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1st Aid Communication

In order to improve efficiency at school, all 1st Aid communication home will now be done via phone call. This will replace the combination of standard emails and calls for more serious incidents that were used previously. Where the call is simply to report a routine treatment, a member of staff will leave a message if there is no answer. Where there is a more serious incident or emergency, a member of staff will continue to call all available numbers until there is an answer.

Whole School Photo

RPS is considering having a whole school photo taken this academic year, instead of the usual class 'vistas'. This is something the school hasn't had done since 2008 and would be great for the children to be part of. We would like to gauge parental interest, as we would need to sell at least 20 photographs to cover the cost.
