To that end, we are pleased to confirm that after consulting closely for some time with senior leaders and the Department for Education, **Bohunt Education Trust (BET)** has been identified as our chosen sponsor. 
After our first meeting, it is our plan to be in touch again early in the Autumn Term to share a more detailed update about next steps.
