Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year! We hope this letter finds all our families well, having had an enjoyable Christmas. All staff at RPS are well and looking forward to welcoming back the pupils on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup>, when school will be fully open as usual.

At the beginning of a new term, we'd like to provide all parents and carers with some important notices and reminders.

### COVID

The world, our nation and our locality are in the middle of the 'Omicron' variant surge, thus we must continue to all do our part to reduce infection spread.

- If your child is symptomatic, please notify the school and take the child for a PCR test asap. The child should not attend school until a negative test is returned.
- If you are notified that your child is a close contact, they should continue to attend school as usual unless they have been told by Test and Trace to isolate. Please ensure they take daily LFD tests before entering school.
- Please continue use a regular (twice a week) LFD testing regime at home regardless of any specific COVID case situation.
- If your child is required to isolate, current guidance for isolation is reduced to **7 days**, provided certain conditions are met. All people isolating are now required to take LFD tests on **day 6** and **day 7** of isolation. If these are both returned negative, the isolation ends after **7 days**.
- If your child is required to isolate, (assuming they are well), they should access school work every day via the remote learning links found on our school website.
- Please continue to wear masks on the school drive at drop off and pick up.
- Please continue to notify the school of any absence before 9:00am.

### Pick Up and Drop Off

- Times and locations will be the same as before Christmas.
- Drop Off – all in by **9:00am**. Gruffalo, Unicorn and Hobbit via main drive/gate. Pegasus via front drive and Pegasus fire door
- Pick Up – Gruffalo and Unicorn at **3:20pm** via main drive/gate. Hobbit at **3:30pm** via main gate/drive. Pegasus at **3:30pm** via front drive and Pegasus fire door.
- All the above apply unless your child is attending an after school club. In this case the pick up time is specified in the club letter.
